New Dress Code

Tokyo Golf Club has revised its dress code, in order to maintain its reputation and tradition. Players are requested to observe the new dress code. Please also make note of the dress code in advance when inviting or introducing guests.

1. Dress code before and after playing golf

Please wear a jacket in the clubhouse before and after playing golf. However, this does not apply during the period from July 1 to September 30. Players are requested to refrain from wearing shorts when they visit Tokyo Golf Club. Please make sure to change clothes in the locker room.

2. Dress code for the golf course (See the illustration.)

1. Shirts

In principle, **male** players shall wear a shirt with a fold-over collar or a fold-over turtleneck. Please refrain from wearing T-shirts, sweatshirts, high-necked shirts, stand-up collar shirts, or similar types of shirts. We do not accept the wearing of long-sleeve undershirts, etc., (including shirts using high-tech sports materials) over a short-sleeve polo shirt, for both **male** and **female** players. Such shirts may be worn if they are not visible. Please tuck your shirttail into your pants. A shirt with a fold-over collar is also desirable for **female** players, but a high-necked shirt or stand-up collar shirt is acceptable. However, the collar should be of a certain height, and please refrain from wearing a shirt that is confusingly similar to a T-shirt. Against our better judgment, we accept shirttails hanging outside only if the shirt is an overblouse-style shirt.

2. Sweaters

When wearing a sweater, both **male** and **female** players are requested to wear a shirt with a fold-over collar or a fold-over turtleneck shirt underneath.

3. Pants

Jeans, sweatshirts, and similar clothes are unacceptable for both **male** and **female** players. Cargo pants (pants with pockets on the thigh, etc.) and similar pants are also unacceptable. **Male** players are requested to wear knee-high socks when they wear shorts, Bermuda shorts, etc. Shorts that are too short in length are unacceptable for both **male** and **female** players. Skirts that are too short in length are also unacceptable for **female** players.

3. Dress code for female players

Female players may wear cropped pants. However, please refrain from wearing extremely slim-fit pants or leggings, etc., under skirts. Please also remove sun-blocking arm covers when in the clubhouse.

4. Dress code for winter conditions

In the clubhouse, please refrain from wearing zip-up jackets, windbreakers, down jackets, quilt vests, etc., as worn on the golf course for cold and wind protection. (This does not apply to the locker room.)
